

## Year 7 LNS Enrichment Curriculum

### Curriculum Intent

Our Year 7 Enrichment curriculum is designed to complement and support our whole school curriculum. By linking our Enrichment curriculum to our core curriculum we are building foundations of academic success in our students from year 7. The focus of the curriculum is to support students to develop their Cultural Capital using our unique location in London but also considering what it means to be a good citizen in the modern world.

### Year 7

T1. **A Classical World** - exploration into ancient history and the mythological world on which so much of our English, Maths, Science and humanities curriculum is built upon.

T2. **A Creative World** - exploration into creative movement and expression through contemporary dance, working in conjunction with Rambert Dance Company,

T3. **An Individual world** - identifying past and present role models and looking at their significance for our lives, considering why some people and some actions are considered significant, thinking about local, national and global contexts.

T4. **A Diverse world** - exploration into the diversity of the world we live in, looking at different cultures in the world, considering gender and identity.

T5. **A Political and global world** - Introduction into human rights, British and global politics, considering how the country is run and how citizens can make a difference.

T6. **A Sustainable World** - looking at ways to promote sustainability at school, in our home environments and how to become 'green' citizens.
