School Return

Uniform Expectations

We have been fully understanding of the issues that many of you have faced replacing items of uniform so close to the end of the school term, including school shoes. On our return after the break, we expect all students to be in full-school uniform. Our uniform must be worn travelling to and from school and your son's smart appearance is an important part of upholding our reputation in and around the local community. It has become noticeable of late that a small number of students have been wearing hoodies and tracksuit tops on their journey to and from school. Both items are prohibited in school and will be confiscated if they are seen to be worn.
