CURRICULUM

At London Nautical School we offer a range of A level and vocational courses designed to provide students with an engaging and personalised programme of study. Along with their A levels and vocational study we also offer all students the opportunity to take a qualification in Sailing and Water sports or to complete the Extended Project qualification. The Extended Project Qualification allows students to engage in a project of their own personal interest and is highly regarding by most Universities. Our Sailing and Water sports course offers students a unique opportunity to develop a professional qualification in the maritime industry.

Our curriculum is designed to allow students to progress onto higher education, apprenticeship or employment. Along with our enrichment programme we equip our students with the skills they need to make the next step.

We encourage students to take responsibility for their own learning. Our dedicated tutor team supports the students as they become independent learners and make the progression into adulthood.

Situated at the heart of London's South Bank, we work with many different institutions to provide numerous enrichment opportunities for our Sixth Form students. Recently we have partnered with Price Waterhouse Coopers and the Bank of New York who provide academic mentoring for potential Oxbridge students and personal statement workshops. Projects that we have run range from bespoke taster days with London South Bank University, art projects with the Southbank Centre and STEM workshops with Imperial College London and King's College London.

As part of our commitment to ensuring all our Sixth Form students are given the opportunity to experience what London has to offer we support all students in finding relevant work experience in a field of study that interests them.

NAUTICAL

At London Nautical School we are proud of our rich nautical heritage and strong career opportunities into the Maritime Sector at the end of education. Uniquely at London Nautical School, we offer a maritime based Sailing and Watersports BTEC qualification that is equivalent to one AS level. Running alongside this qualification is also the STCW95 commercial endorsement required for anyone wishing to join the Merchant Navy. Power-boating and instructor courses can also be studied alongside the sixth form A level and BTEC curriculum.

Using the school's fleet of powerboats, students will gain experience of operating on the river Thames and in coastal locations.

As part of this qualification you will be able to pursue a career within the varied and diverse maritime industries, both in the commercial and leisure sectors. With strong links to merchant shipping companies, sponsorship is available to gain a university graduate degree and enter employment immediately after university without needing to pay university fees. Opportunities to gain RYA Instructor qualifications and experience are also achievable using the school's fleet of sailing dinghies and links to sailing clubs and organisations.

Core units and topics covered within the BTEC course include Practical Sailing Skills, Governing Bodies and Employment Legislation, Customer Service Skills, Navigation and Seamanship, VHF SCR and First Aid and Fire-fighting and Sea Survival Skills.





LONDON NAUTICAL FOOTBALL ACADEMY

The London Nautical Football Academy gives aspiring young players the opportunity to combine their academic studies with a first class football programme.

Led by ex-professional players, Bobby Bowry and Charlie McDonald, the football coaching is delivered by Volenti Academy and offers an insight into the professional football environment, providing up to 8 hours of practical training per week.

At the Academy, players have the option to study: - Level 3
Btec Extended diploma in Sport (Equivalence of 3 A-Levels)
- A Levels (3 A Levels) - Selection of Vocational courses (inc, ICT, Leisure Tourism, Sport, Science).
