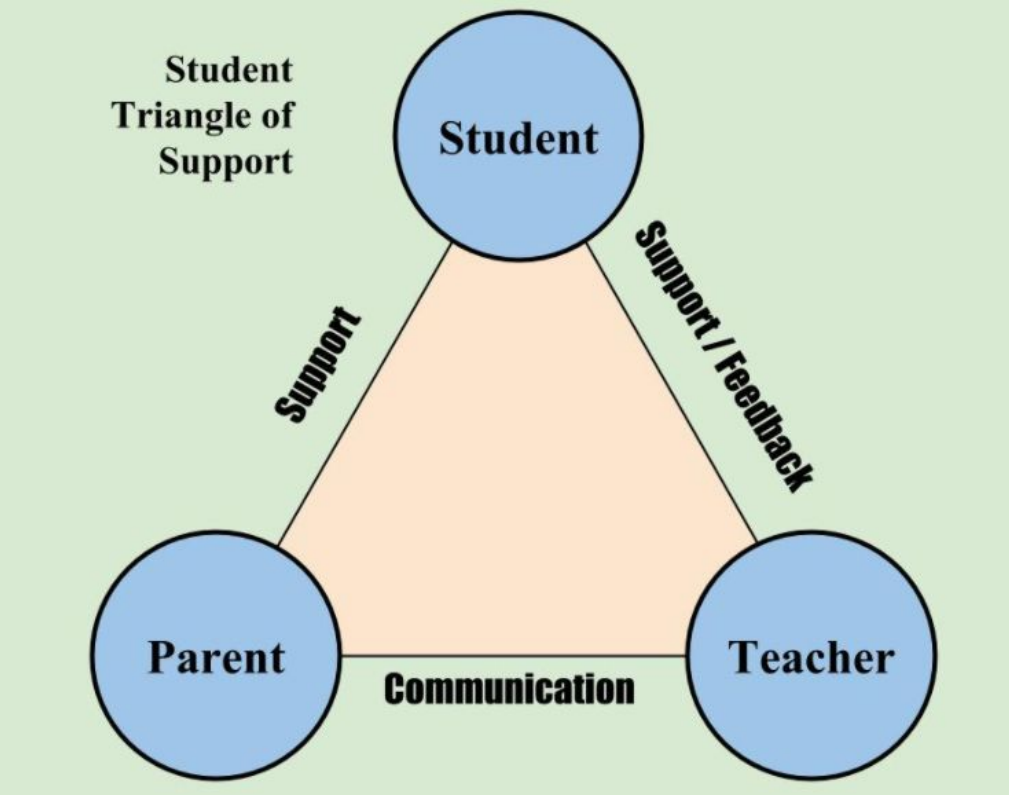
Triangle of Support
