Dear Parents/Carers,

This week we welcomed our year 10 students back for their first 'face to face' session. It was lovely to see them again and we are looking forward to working with them over the next few weeks.

The first week was dedicated to ensuring that our students felt safe back in school and to look after their mental well being. We took students through the safety procedures and outlined how the school was observing social distancing. All students had a mindfulness session that allowed them to reflect on any concerns or worries they may have had about returning to school.

For the next four weeks we have planned our provision to focus on supporting the academic learning of our pupils in the core subjects, English, Math and Science. Each pupil will get a two hour session of each core subject. The timetable of how this is structured is below. Each 'bubble' on each day will receive the same learning in the core subjects.
