Teaching that inspires me, that challenges me, that gives me a lifelong love of learning

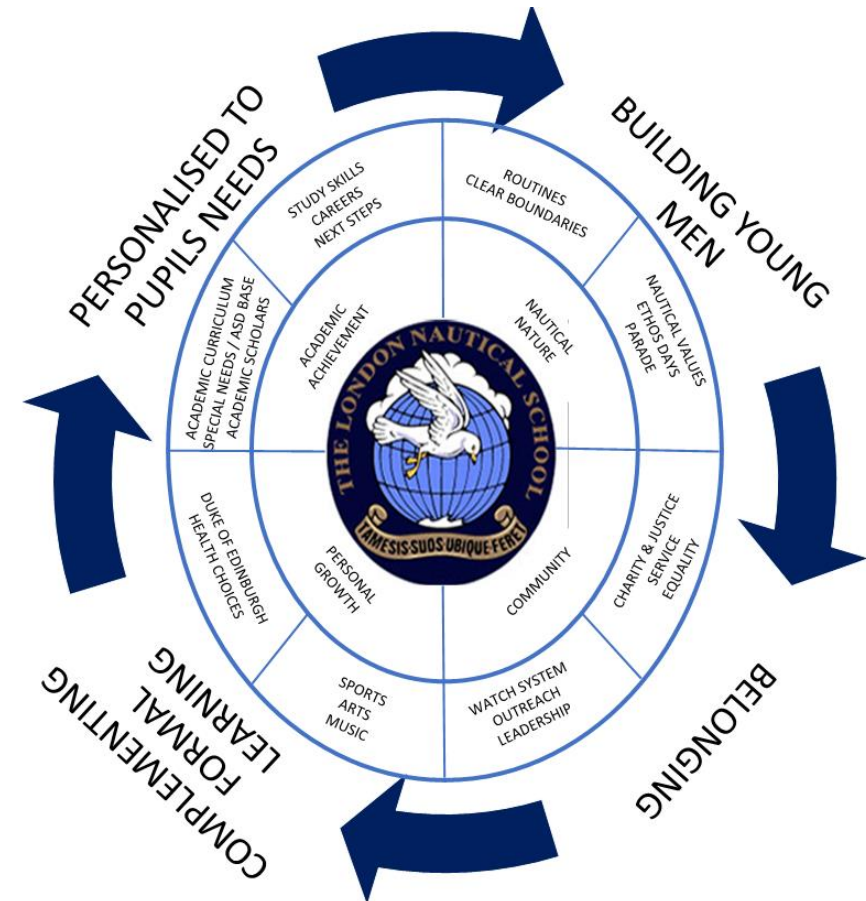
